

St. Anne's Catholic High School for Girls GCSE Results 2022

GCSE attainment at St. Anne's remains outstanding and significantly above national statistics with the school once again securing very high standards at Key Stage 4, in addition to making significant improvements this year at Grades 9-7. This is the first summer GCSE exam series since 2019. Some of the most significant achievements are as follows:

Summary of Key Headlines

- Attainment 8: The Attainment 8 score, which measures a student's average grade across eight subjects, is 59.78 (2019: 56.96)
- Strong Pass in English and Mathematics: The percentage of students achieving at least grade 5+ in both English and mathematics is outstanding at 66% (2019: 64%).
- Standard Pass in English and Mathematics: The percentage of students achieving at least grade 4+ in both English and Mathematics is outstanding at 86% and 13% higher than 2019 (2019: 73%).
- **Top Grades:** Achievement at the top end is excellent. 9% of all entries were grade 9 (*National: 6.6% England Only*) and 38% of all entries were grades 9-7 (*National: 26% England Only*). Grade 9 achievement in the core subjects compared with those at 2019 is significantly higher. There were 27 grade 9s in English Language and English Literature (2019: 24); 7 grade 9s in Mathematics (2019: 6); 44 grade 9s in Science Combined & Triple (2019: 9) and 32 grade 9s in Religious Studies (2019: 33).
- Overall subject achievement is excellent at 9-4 (standard pass). 89% of all grades are 9-4 (National: 73% England Only). Of the 22 GCSE subjects, 20 achieved more than 80%+ at grades 9-4 and 12 subjects achieved more than 90% at grades 9-4.
- **Overall subject achievement** is excellent at grades 9-5 (strong pass). 75% of all grades are 9-5. 18 subjects achieved grades 9-5 of 70% and above.
- GCSE attainment in English and Mathematics is excellent, building on historically strong attainment. 35% of students were awarded the higher grades of 9-7 in English Language. An improvement of 5 % on the 2019 value.
- 44% of students were awarded the higher grades of 9-7 in English Literature. This is above the provisional 16-year-old national data (England Only) for English Language at 23.5%, at grades 9-7 and English Literature 24.1% grades 9-7.
- 38% of students were awarded the higher grades of 9-7 in mathematics. This is above the provisional 16-year-old national data (England Only) for mathematics at 24% at grades 9-7.

- 77% of students attained grades 9-5 in English Language. This is above the provisional 16-year-old national data (England Only) for English Language at 61.1 %
- Grades 9-5. 87% of students attained grades 9-5 in English Literature. This is above the provisional 16-year-old national data (England Only) for English Literature at 62.4% grades 9-5.
- 68% of students achieved grades 9-5 in mathematics. This is above the provisional 16-year-old national data (England Only) for mathematics at 56.6% grades 9-5. 87% of student's attained grades 9-4 in English Language and 91% of student's attained grades 9-4 in English Literature. This is above the provisional 16-year-old national data for English Language at 77.2% grade 4 or higher and 94% grade 4 or higher in English Literature.
- 88% of students attained grades 9-4 in mathematics. This is significantly above the provisional 16-year-olds national data for mathematics at 75.1% grade 4 or higher.

St. Anne's students have again achieved outstanding results with an A Level pass rate of 97%. 2022 is the first summer A Level series of exams since 2019 and our Key Stage 5 results show a significant increase across key measures.

Some of the most significant achievements are as follows:

Summary of Key Headlines

- 33% of all students were awarded A*- A grades, an increase of around 25% on 2019 results.
- Over 80% of students achieved A*- C, a 29% increase on 2019 results.

- Average Point Score (per A Level entry): is **33.97** (2019: 25)
- Average Point Score (expressed as a grade): is C+ (2019: C-).

Applied General

- Average point score (per Applied General entry): 34.68 (2019: 30.65)
- Average Point Score (expressed as a grade): is **D** (Distinction) (2019: D-).
