## Joint Music Festival, St. Anne's and St. Ignatius College

Last year, we conducted this wholly as an online event where over 50 students submitted recordings of their performances or compositions online, which were then shortlisted, with Finalists being awarded prizes by an external Adjudicator. - To enter, students need to send a **video recording** or **audio recording (MP3)** of their performance or composition to <u>music@st-annes.enfield.sch.uk</u> or via Teams to Ms Fernando.
- When students send their video/audio recording, they also need to confirm they can make it to the Finals at St. Ignatius College if they are selected for the LIVE finals. There will be a Forms permission link for parents/carers to sign. This will be published shortly.
- The deadline for submitting entries is **Friday 13 January 2023**.
- A shortlist of finalists will then be made with the Challenge Class Final taking place on Tuesday
  31st January 2023
- Students are to contact Ms Fernando or Dr Viljoen via Teams if you have any queries.

Finalists will perform at the LIVE FINALS on Tuesday 31 January 2023, 6pm at St. Ignatius College with an external Adjudicator.
