Re: May Half Term

I am writing to inform you about the upcoming May half term break and provide some important details regarding the schedule and uniform expectations.

The school will close for the May half term on **Friday, 26th May at 3:10 pm**. After dismissal, we kindly request that all students promptly make their way home and refrain from lingering around the Enfield Town area.

The school will re-open on **Monday 5th June** at the usual time.

Uniform for the Summer Term - 5th June 2023 to 20th July 2023

To ensure clarity and consistency, we would like to outline our expectations for student attire during the final half-term of the academic year:

Blazer: While wearing the school blazer is not compulsory, please note that no alternative jacket is allowed. Students should not substitute the school blazer with hooded, denim or fashion jackets.

Blouse: Students are required to wear a white reverse collared blouse, which should be neatly tucked into the waist of the kilt.

Kilt: It is important to wear the kilt without turning or rolling the waistband to adjust the length. The kilt must not be shorter than 5 centimeters above the knee.

School Jumper or Cardigan: Although not mandatory, students may choose to wear a navy jumper or cardigan with the school logo.

Socks/Tights: Students should wear navy or black socks up to the knee (not over the knee or ankle) or navy or black tights.

Shoes: Black formal low-heeled shoes are to be worn by all students. Canvas, suede or fabric shoes, black ballet shoes, plimsolls, black trainers, or boots are not acceptable.

Please note that the uniform code applies at all times, including during travel to and from school. The PE kit uniform remains the same for the summer term.

We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring that students adhere to the uniform expectations. By maintaining a smart and consistent appearance, we foster a positive learning environment.
