End of Key Stage 4 and Exams

I am incredibly proud of the way the Year 11s have shown resilience, determination and motivation to do their best and make the most of this academic year. I write with details of the upcoming exams.

Please note that for morning exams, students must be in school for **07:45**, in order for them to check the seating plan, hand in their phone and receive any final instructions. Your daughter should be in full school uniform and be fully equipped with all she needs for the exam. Students will be able to go home at the end of their afternoon exams. This time may vary and be typically from around 14:30.

Friday 12th May	End of KS4 Mass and Celebration – To take place in the hall during period one
Friday 26th May	Last day of half term. While there are no exams on this day, students are still expected in school as usual. They will be following their normal timetable.
Friday 16th June	This is the last whole-cohort exam. Students who do not take Geography will go home around 10:30. Geography students will leave after their exam
Tuesday 20th June	Final exam – Food Tech. Students will go home after the exam, around 10:30.
Wednesday 21st June	Celebration Event Day – this includes Awards, Speeches and Shirt Signing. Students should arrive at school at the normal time. They will be free to leave after break.
Wednesday 28th June	Exam Contingency Day – please note all students must be in the country and be able to sit an exam should they be required.
Thursday 29th June	End of Year 11 Prom – please see the letter that went home last month or speak Ms Labonne if any further questions
