Dear Parent/Carer

Key Stage 3 – Assessment Fortnight.

I would like to inform you that all students in Years 7, 8 and 9 will be sitting assessments in all subject areas during the period from Monday 8th June to Friday 19th June 2026.

All assessments will take place during normal lessons. For example, the Geography assessment will take place during students' usual Geography lesson. On non-assessment days, normal teaching and learning will continue as usual. Students should therefore continue to bring their books and all necessary equipment to school each day.

An assessment timetable outlining which lessons will include assessments for your daughter's form group will be shared next week.

Some students are entitled to access arrangements, and I would encourage families to continue engaging with our SEND department should they have any questions or require further clarification.

We understand that, for some students, this may be one of their first experiences of sitting a range of formal assessments and they may feel apprehensive. Feeling some level of anxiety is completely normal, and students are encouraged to speak with you, their family, or a trusted adult in school if they have any concerns.
