Groupcall Xpressions

Groupcall Xpressions is an app that you can download free of charge and can be installed on your mobile phone or tablet. It supports both Apple iOS and Android devices.

Xpressions is a dynamic service available for parents and carers to receive information about their child's school life, ensure communication between the school is easier and more effective, as well as knowing how best to support their development and progress.

It is important to note that the Xpressions app should only be downloaded to parent/carer devices and <u>not</u> student devices as this could result in key information being missed.
