Annual School Fund Contribution: Academic Year September 2022 – July 2023

Together we can make a difference

I am writing to you on behalf of the Governing Body to remind those of you that are able, but not have done so already, to consider making a voluntary contribution into the School Fund. Currently, the suggested voluntary contribution is £120pa per family

As St. Anne's is a voluntary aided school, the Governing Body must make a significant financial contribution for building improvements. Last year we were obliged to contribute towards new substantive pipework at the upper site. This year we are having some building lighting uprated at the upper site and expect to have our fire doors upgraded, primarily at the lower site.

These capital works improve upon our educational infrastructure, and by virtue the quality of education we offer. We are an outstanding, world class school and aim to continue to be so. But we need your help to continue to meet the building obligations that supports and is intrinsic to your daughters education

Therefore, I would like to thank all families who have already contributed to the School Fund so far. But encourage those of you who have not, and have the means to do so, to help enable our Governors to fulfil their responsibility and make an annual voluntary contribution of £120. Note, the annual payment is per family (not per student) and works out at £10 per family per month over 12 months. Paying by instalments is also an option if you would prefer

We do understand it is difficult for some families in our community to contribute the suggested amount. Please pay what you can when you can. Every little helps!

Methods of Payment

As we are cashless school we would prefer you to pay through ParentPay. You will find the invitation to pay on your daughter's ParentPay Account. If you have more than one daughter at St. Anne's please pay against one only

We will also be pleased to accept payment by the following methods:

- Credit or Debit Card. We can take payments over the phone
- Cash (not cheques). Please place your contribution in a named envelope and hand it in at the office
- Bankers' Direct Debit: Please contact the Finance Office (finance@st-annes.enfield.sch.uk or 020 8920 5228) to request a form. You can pay annually, half-yearly or monthly.
