## Re: Strike Day Provision

You will be aware that the National Education Union (NEU) have called upon their members to take further strike action on the following dates which will affect our school's functioning:

- 1. Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March
- 2. Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March
- 3. Thursday 16th March

The industrial action is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the Government over teachers' pay and conditions, not because of any issues at our school or within the local authority.

The safe supervision of children is of the utmost importance and given that we anticipate significantly reduced numbers of both management and teaching staff on these dates I have taken the following decisions:

On Thursday Year 11 Separate Science students will finish and leave school at 13:55

Year 8, 9 and 10 will work from home and, where feasible, will be set work.

We look forward to seeing all students at school, normal time, on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March.
